

Matthew Mead MD is a board certified, fellowship trained hip and knee orthopedic surgeon serving all of Northern Michigan, with clinic locations in Petoskey, Cheboygan, and Gaylord. His practice focuses primarily on treating hip and knee arthritis, whether from chronic degeneration, post-traumatic arthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, or other autoimmune degenerative conditions. Dr. Mead is a lifelong Michigander, having received his Doctorate at the University of Michigan Medical School and residency training at McLaren Flint and Hurley Hospital. He then completed a fellowship at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center focusing on complex hip and knee reconstruction.
