

Dr. Joshua Meyerson, M.D. M.P.H.

Dr. Meyerson is currently serving as the Medical Director for three local health departments in Northern Michigan - the Health Department of Northwest Michigan, Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department, and District Health Department No. 4. He has been a practicing public health physician since 2000. As a public health physician, he is directly responsible to the Health Officer and collaborates with them in the establishment and maintenance of basic public health services. He supervises all direct medical services provided by the Department and is responsible for all standing medical orders and serves as Medical Director for several school-based health centers that are run by the Local Health Departments.

Dr. Meyerson is Board Certified in Pediatrics. He obtained his Medical Degree and Masters in Public Health from Tulane University and completed his Pediatrics Residency at the University of New Mexico. He is a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, a member of the Michigan Association of Public Health and Preventive Medicine Physicians and serves on the Michigan Advisory Committee on Immunizations.
